School Site Council

School Site Council Overview:

The **School Site Council (SSC)** is an opportunity for parents, students, and school staff to be involved with decision making at the school.

The SSC's main responsibilities are to:

- Help develop yearly goals and budget (Local Control Accountability Plan)
- Monitor the implementation and effectiveness of the plan on an ongoing basis
- Serve as an advisory team for the Principal
- Any other goal/objective the SSC collectively decides to take on for the year.

Expectations

- Attend SSC meetings every 4-6 week for ~one hour.
- Regularly attend school community events and maintain visibility with all school families
- Collaborate and team with school leaders and staff to problem-solve school-site

School Site Council Overview:

El **Consejo del Plantel Escolar (SSC)** es una oportunidad para que los padres, estudiantes y personal escolar participen en la toma de decisiones en la escuela.

Las principales responsabilidades del SSC son:

- Ayudar a desarrollar metas y presupuestos anuales (Plan de responsabilidad de control local)
- Monitorear la implementación y efectividad del plan de manera continua.
- Servir como equipo asesor del director Cualquier otra meta / objetivo que el SSC decida asumir colectivamente para el año.

Expectativas

- Asista a las reuniones del SSC cada 4-6 semanas durante aproximadamente una hora.
- Asistir regularmente a eventos de la comunidad escolar y mantener la visibilidad con todas las familias de la escuela.
- Colaborar y formar equipo con los líderes y el personal de la escuela para resolver problemas en el sitio escolar

Learning Continuity & Attendance Plan (LCP)

The purpose of the LCP is to describe:

- 1. How we are providing school instruction and services during the pandemic;
- 2. The actions and strategies we are employing in delivering in-person & distance learning;
- 3. How we are supporting struggling learners, ELs, and SWDs; and
- 4. How we are using the funds available towards these strategies.



First, a word about Budget...


Our schools are receiving additional funding from the state and federal government (via the CARES ACT) The funding is called Learning Loss Mitigation Funding or **LLMF**.

- The funds come from three different funding sources (called CR, GF and GEER) and are being allocated using three different funding formulas.
- The purpose of the funding is to support pupil academic achievement and mitigate learning loss related to COVID-19 school closures.
- The Coronavirus Relief (CR) Fund and General Fund (GF) portions can be used for expenses from March 1, 2020 December 30, 2020.
- The Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund portion can be used for expenses from March 13, 2020 September 30, 2022.



Our Plan For Allocating Funds

- Coded allowable unbudgeted FY20 expenses to CR grant
- Use personnel expenses from 2020-21 related to academic intervention
 - Academic Interventionists
 - General Paraprofessionals
 - ELD Specialists (after Title III sped)
 - Mental Health Counselors (non-SPED portion)
 - Teacher Residents
 - Dean of Students
 - 3rd AP at Blanca and Jose

- Summer School Expenses
- Internet Reimbursement
- Marketing Expenses Related to to Recruiting in Virtual Space




LCP: Distance Learning

Key Actions	Budget (est.)
Chromebooks	\$57,000
Social Emotional Learning and Mental Health Support	\$51,000
Instructional Materials	\$28,000
Staff Device Purchases and Support	\$22,500
Hotspots for Students and Families	\$22,000
Home Office Support for Staff	\$13,000



Attendance & Engagement So Far





Attendance Plan

Each morning:

- A staff member takes attendance by 8:10am and begins calling students that are not logged in to zoom.
- The staff member helps students log in until 8:30am
- At 8:30am, the engagement team begins to call students who are marked absent for subsequent classes.

Each afternoon:

- Teachers record if they received assignments or talked to students or families who were not present in class.
- This information is sent to Ms. Perez to adjust students' attendance for the day.



Re-Engagement Plan

Students are identified for re-engagement if they have not engaged with 60% of their classes for the week.

The Dean of Students calls and checks-in with students and families & makes a plan to increase engagement.

For students who are in further need, we have partnered with The City Peace Project:

- community members reach out to students and families
- may conduct home visits and identify resources to help families support their students.
